The UN reports that 14 million people in Yemen may be on the brink of famine. More than half of Yemenis do not have enough eat. The crisis in Yemen, caused by prolonged conflict, has led to staggering impacts on human life, basic public services and the economy.

Despite the extreme bad weather, the Concert for Yemen and Bangladesh raised enormous support for famine relief for Yemen and Bangladesh. Few Hundreds of people attended the concert to raise money and awareness for children in Yemen and Bangladesh. The Concert for Yemen and Bangladesh was the first benefit concert of its kind in San Diego.

CNN reported an estimated 85,000 children under the age of 5 may have died from extreme hunger or disease since the war in Yemen.

HelpAHand.org hold its annual Thanksgiving Dinner at Families for Children, Dhaka serving dinner to homeless kids those never heard the word Thanksgiving dinner. All the children @ Families for Children have been completely abandoned and are considered to have no families. At FFC the children to learn English and computers, along with academic subjects, so their future will be brighter.



HelpAHand Medial Camps for Rohingya

More than a million Rohingya have been driven into Bangladesh (as of January 2019). Over half of them are children.

The speed and scale with which over one million Rohingya refugees have crossed over the border to Cox's Bazaar camp in Bangladesh has led to a critical emergency. Rohingya are the most persecuted stateless minority in the world, resulting in poor health and nutrition. They have been given temporary shelter in makeshift camps without basic amenities on the outskirts of small villages. Most of the refugees have had no access to healthcare for decades.

HelpAHand worked with other non-profit organization at Ukhiya, Cox's Bazaar, Bangladesh, providing medical care and distributing medications using a mobile clinic model. We treated hundreds of patients every day and walked through the camps to reach otherwise inaccessible areas. Due to security reasons, refugees are not allowed to leave the camps, so mobile clinics are the only source of healthcare.

There has been continuing deterioration in the health status of Rohingya refugees. Because of the lack of clean water, sanitation and hygiene, most of the population have a transmittable disease. Chronic malnourishment has led to common deficiencies such as blindness from a lack of vitamin A. There is a lack of resources for ongoing or longterm healthcare, so patients presenting with fractures or diabetes struggle to receive basic care.
